### Project Coach Duties

- ✓ Coaching / assistant coaching for the project under the leadership of the International Coach and High Performance Director where applicable
- ✓ Team Leader role where applicable
- ✓ Participating in all aspects of the project (coach meetings, team meetings, etc.)
- ✓ Includes supervising athletes through all phases of travel, training and competitions as well as daily coaching responsibilities

### Coaching Allocation Priority

- ✓ Preference will be given to those:
  - Coaches holding minimum NCCP Advanced Coaching Diploma Candidate, Competition - Development ("Trained") / Level III Certification, or equivalent;





- Coaches of an athlete(s) who clearly demonstrate medal potential;
- Coaches who have multiple athletes on the competition team
- Previous experience producing international level or National team athletes
- ✓ Ability in the technical application of a training and competition plan
- ✓ Effective communication skills

Projects may be considered for Competition Development evaluation or Level IV / Competition Development – Advanced specific tasks. Please note you must be registered in the Level IV / NCI NCCP Program for this project to be considered as a specific task.

All coaches must meet a level of competency appropriate to the level of competition of the event. The COC will set the standards to be met for inclusion in all major games. Coaches should demonstrate a minimum of level three certification (or equivalency) to coach internationally, and should be progressing towards level four certification to coach at the Senior World Championship or major games.

**Code of Conduct**

Coaches assigned to Wrestling Canada Lutte trips will be expected to sign the Coaching Association of Canada Coaches Code of Conduct and be positive and productive members of Team Canada.
