## **Developmental Coach Position**

### **Qualifications:**

A degree in Physical Education, recreation or leisure studies, physiology or psychology may be beneficial. As a qualified coach you must have the NCCP Community Sport Coach certified, NCCP Competition Coach trained and Making Ethical Decisions. Previous NCCP Levels 1 and 2 full certification may be recognized. Relevant practical work experience is also essential.

The ideal candidate will be an energetic and enthusiastic individual with a competitive background as a National level wrestler or coach; be well organized and responsible; be able to communicate well with a diverse community of middle school and high school boys, girls, and coaches in an urban environment; and have an understanding of the role of competitive athletics in the character development of children.

### **Primary responsibilities for this position includes:**

Introducing wrestling to middle schools physical education classes; running high school age club practices; evening practices at regional training centre; weekly hours will vary depending on the season. Coach will also be involved in running winter and summer camps.

Successful candidates must have a demonstrated ability to manage multiple tasks, and will need to pass a background check and hold a valid driver's license.

This position requires some regional and national travel with groups of student-athletes and will require flexible hours with an emphasis on afternoon & evening practices and competitions.
