Athletes in the U17 age group are not allowed to compete in the U19 age group.</p>
<b>CADET TEAM TRIALS</b>	<b>CADET TEAM TRIALS:</b> 16 or 17 years of age (born in 2001 or 2002); 15 years of age (born in 2003) may compete – parental authorization and a medical certificate are required.

<p><b>CADET TEAM TRIALS</b></p>	<p><b>MEN'S FREESTYLE (FS):</b> 41-45, 48, 51, 55, 60, 65, 71, 80, 92, 110 kg</p> <p><b>WOMEN (WW):</b> 36-40, 43, 46, 49, 53, 57, 61, 65, 69, 73 kg</p> <p>Please be aware that in order to be eligible (to qualify) to compete in the Cadet Team Trials (Men's Freestyle &amp; Women), you must compete in the current Canadian Championships and you must:</p> <p>1 – Place top 3 as a U17 at the 2018 U17 Canadian Championships; OR 2 – Place top 5 as a 17-year-old (born in 2001) at the 2018 U19 Canadian Championships OR if you are a 17-year-old (born in 2001) that is directly eliminated (i.e. second loss of the tournament) by an 18-year-old (born in 2000) that places in the top 5.</p>
<p><b>REGISTRATION</b></p>	<p>All athlete and support staff (coaches, team leaders, medical, officials) registrations and payments, where applicable, must be made through the Championship Registration Portal (<a href="https://register.wrestling.ca/2018-u17-u19-canadian-wrestling-championships/">https://register.wrestling.ca/2018-u17-u19-canadian-wrestling-championships/</a>)</p> <p>Other requirements for participation will also be found in the registration portal.</p> <p>The registration deadline is <b>March 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2018</b> at 11:59 pm ET. Late registrations will be accepted until <b>March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2018</b> at 11:59 pm ET, but will be subject to a late fee as outlined in the "Entry Fees" section below. <b>No registrations will be accepted after March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at 11:59 pm ET.</b> This applies to all athletes, coaches and support staff.</p> <p>All athletes and support staff must be registered members of their PTSO and be members in good standing with the PTSO and WCL as of the time of weigh-in for the event. Please check with your PTSO to determine if they have any additional registration requirements. Officials must be registered members in good standing with the Canadian Association of Wrestling Officials (CAWO) and their Provincial Wrestling Officials Association (if applicable).</p>
<p><b>COACHES</b></p>	<p>To receive a coach accreditation (eligible to coach during the event), coaches must have the following MINIMUM elements recorded in their NCCP transcripts, NO LATER than March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2018:</p> <p>1 – Make Ethical Decisions Evaluation 2 – Competition Introduction CERTIFIED status</p>
<p><b>ENTRY FEES</b></p>	<p>Payment of entry fees will be done through the WCL online Registration Portal with the exception of Cadet Trials (Men's Freestyle and Women), which will take place on-site once eligibility (qualification) is confirmed at the end of each day of competition (April 13<sup>th</sup> for men's freestyle and April 14<sup>th</sup> for women freestyle). Competitors must be members in good standing with their PTSO and Wrestling Canada Lutte.</li> <li>▪ Men's Freestyle and Women's competition is closed to Canadian citizens and those individuals with Permanent Resident status. Cadet Team Trials are closed to Canadian citizens only. Legal proof of age and citizenship status must be provided when registering online and at weigh-ins.</li> <li>▪ Greco-Roman competition (men and women) is open to all competitors.</li> </ul>
