The Assistant Coach works with the McMaster Head Coach on all coaching elements associated with the sports program. Reporting to Hamilton Wrestling Club Board and McMaster Head Coach, the successful candidate will be responsible to assist in overall direction, planning, recruitment, technical and tactical preparation of the club and varsity teams. Together with the McMaster Head Coach, the Assistant Coach will assist in designing and implementing a comprehensive sport development plan conducive to positioning HWC as a top level club in Canada.

As the Hamilton Wrestling Club Assistant Coach, you will report to the HWC Board of Directors and be responsible for the training, preparation, and development of club and varsity athletes both in training and competition settings. Between the two organizations there will be an expectation of part time hours of 2-3 hours (4-5) days a week in Winter and Summer months by the successful candidate. Significant travel to competitions and other events is required.

- Be knowledgeable in the technical, tactical, physical, and psychological elements of wrestling
- An understanding of the intended delivery model of the wrestling program within HWC
- Strength in recruiting and/or other relevant training or teaching related to sport
- Willingness to work flexible hours including evenings and weekends
- Competitive experience at the national/international level are required
- Through the National Coaching Certification Program, the candidate must be actively pursuing completion of the Competition - Development stream
