<p><b>REGISTRATION</b></p>	<p>All athlete and support staff (coaches, team leaders, medical, officials) registrations and payments, where applicable, must be made online through Trackie.reg Registration will open January 21<sup>st</sup>, 2019</p> <p>Other requirements for participation will also be found on Trackie.reg under the tournament information.</p> <p>The registration deadline is <b>March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018</b> at 11:59 pm ET. Late registrations will be accepted until <b>March 8<sup>th</sup>, 2019</b> at 11:59 pm ET, but will be subject to a late fee as outlined in the “Entry Fees” section below. <b>No registrations will be accepted after March 8<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at 11:59 pm ET.</b> This applies to all athletes, coaches and support staff.</p> <p>All athletes and support staff must be registered members of their PTSO and be members in good standing with the PTSO and WCL as of the time of weigh-in for the event. Please check with your PTSO to determine if they have any additional registration requirements. Officials must be registered members in good standing with the Canadian Association of Wrestling Officials (CAWO) and their Provincial Wrestling Officials Association (if applicable).</p>
<p><b>COACHES</b></p>	<p>To receive a coach accreditation (eligible to coach during the event), coaches must have the following MINIMUM elements recorded in their NCCP transcripts, NO LATER than March 8<sup>th</sup>, 2019:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1 – Make Ethical Decisions Evaluation</li> <li>2 – Competition Development (Performance Coach) CERTIFIED status</li> </ul>
<p><b>SCREENING (POLICE CHECKS)</b></p>	<p>As part of WCL’s commitment to Safe Sport, all support staff (coaches, team managers, team medical, officials) will be required to provide proof of screening NO LATER than March 8<sup>th</sup>, 2019, to receive accreditation. Acceptable screening includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1 – Vulnerable Sector Check for Minors* (VSC) issued within 6 months of the event. A hard copy must be provided to the National Office.</li> </ul> <p>OR</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>2 – Enhanced Police Information Check (E-PIC) issued within 6 months of the event. Please be sure to share your results with Wrestling Canada Lutte. More information to follow in January.</li> </ul> <p>*Please note that if a VSC is not provided in 2019, all support staff (coaches, team managers, team medical, officials) will be required to provide a VSC for Minors, starting 2020.</p>
