

# Canadian Wrestling Trials

- UWW rules (see attached):
  - UWW tie-breaking criteria
  - UWW classification points
  - Injuries – ability to compete will be determined by the Event Physician
  - Forfeits – disqualification from the match and elimination from the Trials
  - If an athlete misses weight, the weight class will NOT be redrawn
- Seeding:
  - Will be communicated after the final entry deadline (with the understanding that seeds are subject to change up until the technical meeting when final weight classes are declared)
- Injury provision wrestle-offs requests:
  - Will be communicated at the technical meeting



# Canadian Wrestling Trials – Draw Clarification

## 5-PERSON BRACKET

- Day 1:
  - Round robin to determine ranking for Day 2
  - If the last match of the round robin doesn't change the outcome of the finalists for Day 2, then this match will be held as part of the finals on Day 2
  - In all other instances, the last match of the round robin will be wrestled on Day 1 to determine the round robin ranking
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> / 4<sup>th</sup> Trials placing is determined by ranking from round robin
- Day 2:
  - Finals (2 of 3) - 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> ranked athletes from round robin
  - The outcome of the head-to-head match between the finalists from Day 1 round robin will be considered as part of the finals



# Canadian Wrestling Trials – Draw Clarification

## 6-PERSON BRACKET

- Day 1:
  - 2 pools of three
  - Round robin within each pool to determine ranking
  - Semi-finals: A1 vs. B2 and B1 vs. A2
- Day 2:
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> / 4<sup>th</sup> placing - losers of semi-finals (if these athletes had a head-to-head match on Day 1, that result will count)
  - Finals (2 of 3) - winners of semi-finals (the outcome of the head-to-head match between the finalists from Day 1 round robin will be considered as part of the finals)



# Canadian Wrestling Trials – Draw Clarification

## 7-PERSON BRACKET

- Day 1:
  - 1 pool of three, 1 pool of four
  - Round robin within each pool to determine ranking
  - Semi-finals: A1 vs. B2 and B1 vs. A2
- Day 2:
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> / 4<sup>th</sup> placing - losers of semi-finals (if these athletes had a head-to-head match on Day 1, that result will count)
  - Finals (2 of 3) - winners of semi-finals (the outcome of the head-to-head match between the finalists from Day 1 round robin will be considered as part of the finals)



# Canadian Wrestling Trials – Draw Clarification

## 8-PERSON BRACKET

- Day 1:
  - Draw completed up to and including semi-finals
- Day 2:
  - Repechage for athletes who lost to finalists
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> / 4<sup>th</sup> placing – winners of repechage to wrestle
  - Finals (2 of 3) - winners of semi-finals
