AGE GROUPS & WEIGHT CATEGORIES	<p>Legal proof of age and photo identification must be provided at the time of on-site weigh-ins (passport or birth certificate with accompanying photo ID will be accepted).</p> <p>SENIOR: 20 years of age +</p> <p>MEN'S FREESTYLE (FS): 61, 70, 79 kg WOMEN (WW): 55, 59, 65, 72 kg</p> <p>NOTE:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Juniors (born in 1999, 2000, 2001) may compete in Senior competition. ▪ Athletes 17 years of age (born in 2002) may compete in Senior competition. Parental authorization and a medical certificate are required. ▪ Athletes 40 years of age and above (born in 1979 or earlier) must provide a medical certificate. <p>*FS 92 kg was not represented at the 2019 Senior Pan American Championships so there is currently no available spot on the Senior World Team. If a spot becomes available on the World Team, consideration for participation at 92 kg will be made by application to the High Performance Director.</p>
COACHES	<p>To receive a coach accreditation (eligible to coach during the event), coaches must have the following MINIMUM elements recorded in their NCCP transcripts, NO LATER than June 28th, 2019:</p> <p>1 – Make Ethical Decisions Evaluation 2 – Competition Development (Performance Coach) CERTIFIED status</p>

<p>SCREENING (POLICE CHECKS)</p>	<p>As part of WCL’s commitment to Safe Sport, all support staff (coaches, team managers, team medical, officials) will be required to provide proof of screening NO LATER than June 21st, 2019, to receive accreditation. Acceptable screening includes:</p> <p>1 – Vulnerable Sector Check for Minors* (VSC) issued no earlier than Sept 01, 2018. A hard copy must be provided to the National Office. OR 2 – Enhanced Police Information Check (E-PIC) issued no earlier than Sept 01, 2018. Please be sure to share your results with Wrestling Canada Lutte. Late registrations will be accepted until June 28th, 2019 at 12:00 pm noon ET.</p> <p>Support Staff Registration (Coaches, Team Leaders, Medical, Officials): The registration deadline is June 21st, 2019 at 11:59 pm ET. <u>No registrations will be accepted after June 21st, 2019 at 11:59 pm ET.</u> This is due to WCL needing sufficient time to review support staff entries, including screening.</p> <p>All athletes, coaches and support staff must be registered members of their PTSO and be members in good standing with the PTSO and WCL as of the time of weigh-in for the event. Please check with your PTSO to determine if they have any additional registration requirements. Officials must be registered members in good standing with the Canadian Association of Wrestling Officials (CAWO) and their Provincial Wrestling Officials Association (if applicable).</p>
<p>ENTRY FEES</p>	<p>Payment of entry fees will be done through the WCL online registration portal.</p> <p>Athlete Entry Fees: Early deadline (June 21st, 2019 by 11:59 pm ET) - \$75.00 CAD Late deadline (between June 22nd, 2019 & June 28th, 2019 at 12:00 pm noon ET) - \$250.00 CAD</p> <p>Scratches All scratches are NON-REFUNDABLE.</p> <p>Please check with your PTSO to determine if any additional fees apply.</p>
