<p>CADET TEAM TRIALS</p>	<p>CADET TEAM TRIALS: 16 or 17 years of age (born in 2003 or 2004); 15 years of age (born in 2005) may compete with written parental consent and a medical certificate.</p> <p><u>MEN'S FREESTYLE (FS):</u> 41-45, 48, 51, 55, 60, 65, 71, 80, 92, 110 kg</p> <p><u>WOMEN (WW):</u> 36-40, 43, 46, 49, 53, 57, 61, 65, 69, 73 kg</p> <p>Please be aware that in order to be eligible (to qualify) to compete in the Cadet Team Trials (Men's Freestyle & Women), you must compete in the current Canadian Championships and you must:</p> <p>1 – Place top 3 as a U17 at the 2020 U17 Canadian Championships; OR 2 – Place top 5 as a 17-year-old (born in 2003) at the 2020 U19 Canadian Championships OR if you are a 17-year-old (born in 2003) that is directly eliminated (i.e. second loss of the tournament) by an 18-year-old (born in 2002) that places in the top 5.</p>
<p>ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS</p>	<p>Competition is closed to Canadian citizens and those individuals with Permanent Resident status. Cadet Team Trials are closed to Canadian citizens only. Legal proof of age and citizenship status will be required during the registration process. Photo identification must be provided at the time of on-site weigh-ins (any Canadian government issued photo identification will be accepted).</p> <p>All athletes and support staff must be registered members of their PTSO and be members in good standing with their PTSO and WCL as of the time of weigh-in for the event. Please check with your PTSO to determine if they have any additional registration requirements.</p> <p>Officials must be registered members in good standing with CAWO and their Provincial Wrestling Officials Association (if applicable) and WCL.</p>

- All scratches before March 06th, 2020 (11:59 pm ET) will be fully refundable.
- All scratches after March 06th, 2020 (11:59 pm ET) & prior to March 20th, 2020 (11:59 pm ET) will be 50% refundable.
- All scratches after March 20th, 2020 (11:59 pm ET) are NON-refundable.
- Injury withdrawals prior to March 30th, 2020 (11:59 pm ET) will be fully refundable, upon submission of a physician’s note.

NOTE: Payment of Cadet Trials fees (Men’s Freestyle and Women) will take place on-site once eligibility (qualification) is confirmed at the end of each day of competition. The cost for Trials is \$40 per athlete (payable on-site).
