

The WCL Competition – Introduction Evaluation Process

The components

There are two components to the evaluation:

1. The Make Ethical Decisions online evaluation (multi-sport);
2. The WCL portfolio evaluation; and
3. The WCL practice evaluation.

The WCL portfolio and practice evaluations are delivered together. The *Make Ethical Decisions* online evaluation is available in the Locker, and free of charge if you have the training module on your NCCP transcript.

Download the portfolio

Go to the WCL coach education page on wrestling.ca, and download the portfolio from the Competition – Introduction section. This same section also lists the training and evaluation requirements:

You will find the following:

1. An Excel spreadsheet for you to use to record three (3) practice plans from different stages of your season;
2. A fillable PDF that you can use to write down your Emergency Action Plan; and
3. A copy of the evaluation tool that will be used by the *coach evaluators*.

Complete steps #1 and #2 prior to...

Putting your name on the waiting list

On the same web page above, use the link near the top of the page to sign up for the waiting list. At that time, you will be asked if you have completed all of the training requirements. If you feel that you have professional experience that makes some training unnecessary, you may ask for a *training pathway exemption* using that same form.





WCL reviews your submission

When your turn comes up, we will review your information from the waiting list as well as your NCCP transcript in the Locker. We will also handle any requests for a *training pathway exemption* at that time.

Both WCL and your provincial/territorial wrestling association must agree that your professional experience warrants it. Either way, you will receive a letter with the final decision.

Your evaluation process is activated

Next, you will receive an email confirming that your evaluation will proceed. You will be asked to submit your portfolio and you will be issued an invoice for \$175 + sales tax.

You are assigned evaluators

Once your invoice has been paid, we will ask you for the dates and time of day when you are able to run a practice session. With that information, we will assign two (2) evaluators to you. The evaluators can be from any province/territory in the country.

They will review the portfolio, ask you to make corrections if necessary, and then schedule the following:

- A briefing prior to the practice;
- The observation of your practice session, using videoconferencing software; and
- A debrief to discuss their observations with you.

Finalizing the results of the evaluations

The evaluators will send out a signed action plan to yourself and WCL. If you passed, there is nothing more for you to do. WCL is responsible for recording the result in the Locker.

If you did not, you will be asked to schedule a second observation.
