- Served on B.C. Wrestling Association Executive. 1967-1982; President 1971-1977
- Instrumental in the restructuring of B.C.W.A., including the writing of a new constitution
- Initiated the establishment of the Paul Nemeth Scholarship for graduating high school wrestlers going on in wrestling
- Through his efforts, the high schools became integrated with B.C.W.A.
- Was a key to the involvement of the B.C.W.A. in the lotteries, thus creating a stronger financial future for the association.

- Secretary of CAWA (WCL) 1974-1979
- Designed the program for the first Junior Development Program
- Was Chairman of National Junior Development from 1973-1979
- Designed the National Manager's Development Program and wrote the first Manager's Handbook
- Served as manager of the Canadian teams for the following:
  - 1971 Pan-American Games – Cali, Colombia
  - 1974 Commonwealth Games – Christchurch, New Zealand
  - 1975 National Tour (Japan and Canada)
  - 1975 Pan-American Games – Mexico
  - 1976 – Olympic Games – Montreal, Canada
