# Safe Sport Participant Fee Report (2024-25)



# GENERAL

Wrestling Canada Lutte (WCL) believes that everyone involved in sport has the right to participate in a safe and inclusive environment that is free of all forms of maltreatment, and has adopted the Universal Code of Conduct to Prevent and Address Maltreatment in Sport (UCCMS).

WCL implemented a Safe Sport Participant Fee Policy in May 2023 with the following key principles:

- Registered participants expect WCL to have safe sport policies to protect such participants.
- WCL's safe sport policies, systems and processes include being a signatory to Abuse-Free Sport & OSIC (formerly) and the new Canadian Safe Sport Program (CSSP), as well as supporting services through an independent third party (ITP), SDRCC and the legal (court) system.
- The costs of these processes will be supported by both Members and registered participants.



# GENERAL

## **Purpose of Report:**

To provide a clear and consistent understanding of how WCL determines, manages and funds safe sport costs for its Registered Participants

## **Key Activities:**

- WCL is a signatory to Abuse-Free Sport & OSIC (ending March 31, 2025)
- WCL completes the transition from Abuse-Free Sport & OSIC to the new Canadian Safe Sport Program (CSSP), effective April 1, 2025
- WCL maintains the services of an independent third party (ITP Sport), including reporting & triage
- ITP accessible for PTSOs on a fee-for-service basis
- Complaint process includes independent investigations & independent discipline / appeal panels, as necessary
- WCL maintains a screening process including an independent screening panel, as required
