

WRESTLING CANADA LUTTE CANADIAN SAFE SPORT PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS

(revised November 25, 2025)

The <u>Canadian Safe Sport Program Rules</u> set out how Sport Integrity Canada (formerly the Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport) independently administers the <u>Universal Code of Conduct to Prevent and Address Maltreatment in Sport (UCCMS)</u> under the Canadian Safe Sport Program (CCSP), effective April 1, 2025.

The Canadian Safe Sport Program (CSSP) shall apply to the following Wrestling Canada Lutte (WCL) Participants, defined under the CSSP Rules and / or defined by WCL¹.

| Participant Type | Description |

| Athletes | Athletes receiving AAP support (carded athletes) Athletes included in the anti-doping National Athlete Pool (NAP) National Team Athletes (Senior, U23, U20, U17)² Athletes that have an active UWW licence |
| Coaches | Any coach or club receiving a WCL coaching grant³ Coaches that have an active UWW licence |
| Team Support Personnel (Medical & Team Leaders) | WCL Integrated Support Team (IST) personnel (e.g. Chief Medical Officer, Therapy Lead, Nutrition Lead, etc.) Any individuals in non-coaching roles that have an active UWW licence (eg. Medical, Team Leader) |
| Officials | Officials that have an active UWW licence |

^{*}NOTE: Participants in WCL led coach education activities are not considered CSSP participants.

¹ Participants directly under WCL's jurisdiction that can be objectively defined and traced.

² First and second ranked athletes from Canadian Championships and / or Trials.

³ For the avoidance of doubt, where a WCL coaching grant is provided to a club and not an individual, this includes ALL coaches at that club.
