SUBJECT: Notice Regarding Singlets for International Club-Based Events

Wrestling Canada Lutte (WCL) would like to provide a notice regarding singlets for athletes attending international competitions.

As part of annual budget and outfitting planning, WCL prioritizes outfitting Canadian athletes competing at major international events, including Pan-American Championships, World Championships, UWW Ranking Series events, and Multi-Sport Games. As a result, athletes attending international events that are considered **club-based competitions** may be required to compete in their club singlet if they have not previously received a WCL-issued Team Canada singlet through participation in one of the events listed above.

IMPORTANT: Effective 2027, any previously issued Team Canada singlets are no longer compliant with current UWW Uniform Regulations.

With this in mind, we strongly encourage all clubs to review the current United World Wrestling (UWW) Uniform Regulations and ensure that their singlets comply with the requirements for international competition:

We ask clubs to pay particular attention to the following areas:

- **Colour requirements:** UWW regulations require clear distinction between red and blue competition singlets. A blue colour should not appear on a red singlet, and a red colour should not appear on a blue singlet.
- **Athlete identification:** The placement of the athlete's name, country code (CAN), and colour band on the back of the singlet has changed under the updated UWW regulations. Clubs should ensure their singlets meet the new specifications.
- **Overall compliance:** Clubs are responsible for ensuring that any singlet used at international competition meets all applicable UWW requirements.

WCL will make every effort to have compliant singlets available for purchase by athletes who do not receive a Team Canada singlet through qualification for major international events. However, due to inventory limitations and production timelines, WCL cannot guarantee that singlets will be available to fulfill all requests.
