The following information will clarify the medical and therapy services available during your stay at the University of Saskatchewan. Should you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me by phone or email. We look forward to hosting you and your team at the U of S.

Services Provided	* A Huskie Team Therapist or student trainer will share venue specific information and will discuss the appropriate Emergency Action Protocol with the visiting medical staff prior to competition time. A copy of the EAP will be provided to the visiting team. * A Physician will be on site during the competition. * There will be no host medical coverage during practices. * Host medical staff will assist with emergency situations. * Canada West visiting teams are expected to provide their own medical representative. Teams may contact the Host Head Therapist for a list of external contractors to secure coverage in the absence of travelling team medical personnel. * The event physician has the authority to withdraw athletes from competition if they are considered to be in poor health or in a condition that is dangerous to themselves or other competitors. * The event physician has the right to stop a bout when there is danger to either athlete. The event physician also has sole authority to decide whether an athlete may continue a bout. In the absence of an event physician, the event medical personnel will have the authority to decide whether an athlete may continue a bout. * Should emergency transport to the Hospital be required, the EAP will outline the protocol via ambulance transport. USask will not be responsible for any charges associated with emergency transportation of visiting athletes, team staff or spectators. Emergency transportation will be arranged through Medavie Health Services Ambulance. Non-emergency transport will be the responsibility of the visiting team.
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	* All athletes must travel with provincial health card information.	
Emergency Equipment	* The host therapist will review the emergency supplies available and their location prior to the competition. * Biohazardous waste management supplies and disposal devices will be supplied. * AED, oxygen and delivery devices, fracture kit, immobilizers, slings, scoop stretcher, spine board, crutches, blanket, ice and ice bags are available in case of an injury. * A trauma bag will be on site.	
Concussion Management	* Visiting athletes that may have sustained a concussion are strongly encouraged to access host medical staff in return to sport decision making * Any athlete that has sustained a potential head injury should be removed from play and not return to any activity that day. * Visiting teams should contact host medical staff to access a private/quiet area for concussion assessment and management. * Visiting teams are strongly recommended to travel with a representative who has completed the Concussion Awareness Training Tool program recommended by U SPORTS	
Injury Communication	* Host medical staff will complete a CW Injury Report Form for any injured athlete reviewed at the competition. A copy of the injury report will be made available to the participant.
